

In forty-one passages Lina Wolff portrays the darker side of craftsmanship, the subconscious nocturnal life that lies behind every type of artistry. The texts are surreal, hilarious, ironic and self-ironic, but more than anything they add unique and unfiltered insight into the creative melting pot that we call literature.

Lina Wolff was born in Lund, Sweden, and lived for several years in Spain and Italy, where she worked as a translator. She arrived on the literary stage in 2009 with the publication of *Many People Die Like You*, a collection of short stories set in Spain and the south of Sweden. In 2012, her debut novel, *Bret Easton Ellis and the Other Dogs*, won the Vi Magazine Literature Prize. In 2016, her second novel, *The Polyglot Lovers*, won Sweden's most esteemed literary award, the August Prize for Fiction, and has been translated into seventeen languages. *Carnality*was awarded the prestigious Aftonbladet Literature Prize in 2019.
