Harp Song from a Silent Wood is a story of love and betrayal chronicling woman's journey from deep within the Norwegian woods to the great concert halls of Europe.

Ane Solingen, an independent woman with captivating eyes, has a unique inner strength. Is this why the people of the village dislike her?
