## Urd

*Urd* is about Seselja and Cecilie, two women living at each end of the twentieth century. It is a book set at a small house in the farmlands of western Norway tying to destinies together. Lillegraven writes with time, as it runs through landscapes and people, the birth of a child, and the visits from the dead.

Ruth Lillegraven debuted in 2005 with a collection of poetry entitled *Big Bad Poems*. Since then, she has published a novel, six poetry collections as well as children books. Her work has been nominated for several prizes and she was awarded, among other distinctions, *The Brage Prize* and *Nynorsk Literature Prize*. Her first psychological crime thriller, *Everything is Mine (Alt er mitt)*, is the first in a series, with huge success and multiple international sales, as well as film rights sold to Nordisk film. *Blood Ties* is the second volume in the "Clara - series".
